Forestry at Harvard.

Harvard University, through the Lawrence Scientific School, has

established a course in forestry, instruction to begin next fall under the direction of Mr. R. T. Fisher, who is now in the employ of the Bureau of Forestry. Mr. Fisher has had considerable experience in the forest problems of this country, being the author or collaborator on several bulletins published by the bureau. He is particularly fitted for a New England school, having given much attention to woodlots and forest conditions in that section of the country. The requirements for admission to the course are the same as those for any other program in the Lawrence Scientific School, and catalogues and circulars giving detailed and definite information may be obtained from the secretary, J.
